Playing the Past Tour

In this special tour, scouts learn how the historical figures they are researching for the “Playing the Past” badge are similar to and different from Mary Todd Lincoln and play games in each room of the house from the eras in which their characters lived.

Scheduling, Rates, and Payment

The “Playing the Past Tour” can be scheduled year round at least two weeks in advance.

In order to customize the program to the historical figures your troop members are studying, we need the names of those figures at the time you schedule the tour, or at least two weeks in advance of the tour.

During regular group tour booking hours (9AM-4PM): \$5 per scout, \$5 per leader, \$8 per other adult chaperone

Outside regular group tour hours (after 4PM, Sundays, or Saturdays in the winter): \$7 per scout, \$7 per leader, \$10 per other adult chaperone.

Cash, Check, or credit card accepted. Full payment due on day of tour. Collect group admission prior to arrival.

Logistics

The museum can not be responsible for scouts if they are dropped off. At least one leader needs to arrive 15 minutes before the tour to supervise scouts that are dropped off. Parents should not leave children until they are certain a troop leader is present. The troop leader should meet the arriving scouts in the back garden or parking lot.

The tour will begin at the scheduled time. Latecomers will need to join the program in progress.

Groups larger than 15 are broken into sub-groups of no more than 15 per tour (including adults and tagalongs), with a maximum of two tours at a time due to space limitations. If your group is larger than 30, special arrangements can be made for a time outside regular group tour hours.

Allow approximately 1 hour for the tour. Add 20 minutes if you want to visit the museum store or restrooms.
