Add *Mrs. Lincoln's famous white cake* made by Sunrise Bakery! Cake is served as cupcakes so they may be eaten in the garden or taken to go. \$40 per batter mixed. Each batter makes approximately 20 cupcakes.

The Museum Tour

- Group tours of the Mary Todd Lincoln House are available by appointment year round.
- Rates during regular group tour booking hours (9AM-4PM) are:
 - \$11 for 15 or more visitors
 - \$12 for less than 15 visitors
 - \$100 minimum required
- When booking outside regular group tour hours, add \$2 per visitor for each of the following that apply :
 - Before 9AM
 - After 4PM
 - Sundays
- Group tours are broken in to sub-groups of no more than 15 and tour simultaneously. Maximum of three guided tours at a time due to space limitations.
- Allow approximately 1 hour for the tour and 20 minutes for the museum store/bathroom facilities, etc... Tours can be shortened upon request.
- If your group is large (75-180), we recommend booking a private "open house" in the evening (after 4:30pm) for a 2-4 hour time block. Guides are stationed throughout the museum to give tour content. Private "open house" bookings are welcome to bring refreshments to set up in the garden.

Downtown Walking Tour

"Lincoln's Lexington Walking Tour"

*Day or evening; 1.5 hours depending on group needs
\$10 per person; minimum of 15 people or \$150*

Mary Lincoln enjoyed an urban upbringing and brought her husband Abraham back to visit her family. The downtown "Lincoln's Lexington" walking tour includes locations relevant to Mrs. Lincoln's childhood, Lexington history and African American history. The tour is approximately 2 miles and lasts approximately an hour and a half.
